HOLIDAYMAKERS are being urged to make sure their insurance policies or travel agents offer cover against "supplier failure".

This bails consumers out if a company providing flights or accommodation goes bust.

The warning comes in the wake of the collapse of Scottish operator Globespan last month, and ahead of possible British Airways strikes at Easter.

"With bad weather, terrorist alerts, possible strikes and

other unforeseen events affecting travel plans, many travel companies are left exposed," said Antony Martin from Insurefor.com.

"As a result, they are leaving their customers without any financial protection."
